8 – Hour Industrial Fire Training

This course is designed for experienced Emergency Response Personnel.

This course provides training for emergency response personnel and opportunities to practice techniques that are necessary in dealing with exterior emergencies.

8 – Hour Foam Operations & Applications

This course has the same classroom modules as the 16-Hour, but without the Live Fire Training. Upon successful completion of this course the participant will be well positioned to pursue additional hands-on foam training. This course consists of lectures, classroom demonstrations, and presentations.

8 – Hour Pre-Emergency Planning for Industrial Facilities

This course is a basic Pre-emergency planning skills training program for industrial facilities. The scope of this course is limited to those standards, laws, and regulations that apply to pre-emergency planning and serves to establish the foundation necessary for additional levels of training. NFPA 1620, Recommended Practice for Pre-Incident Planning, is referenced in this course. This course is designed to bring the industrial worker to a level of training where they will be able to assist their companies in the development of pre-emergency plans to help emergency response personnel effectively manage emergencies.

This course can be delivered at your site or at BEST Complex.

8-Hour Interior Structural Firefighting Refresher

This course is designed to refresh the practical skills of the experienced interior structural firefighter. The course is a refresher firefighting skills training program for fire protection of structural occupancies. The scope of this course is limited to those standards, laws, and regulations that apply to the Interior-level firefighter and serves to hone the skills of the seasoned firefighter. Live fire evolutions are conducted in accordance with NFPA 1403 Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions. Verification of compliance with NFPA 1403, Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions, Chapter 6, paragraph 6.1.1, prescribed minimum training levels, is required.

Minimum number of participants: 10.

16-Hour Foam Operations & Applications

This course is a basic foam firefighting skills training program for fire protection in applicable industrial and municipal situations and includes live fire training. This course is designed to bring even the non-fire oriented worker to a level of training where they will be able to function as a useful member of the industrial fire brigade or fire department regarding foam applications and operations. Upon successful completion of this course the participant will be well positioned to pursue additional foam training.

Minimum number of participants: 15.

16 – Hour Incident Command System /Incident Management System Training

The purpose of this course is to train emergency responders in the application of an Incident Command or Incident Management System. The course introduces the Incident Command System (ICS) and command and control procedures for all sizes and types of emergency incidents. Among other topics the course includes modules on Weapons of Mass Destruction Incidents, introduction to NIMS, and hands-on exercises on the incident command simulator.

Minimum number of participants: 6

30-HOUR BASIC INDUSTRIAL EXTERIOR FIRE TRAINING

This course is a basic firefighting skills training program for fire protection in industrial occupancies and is designed to bring even the non-fire oriented industrial worker to a level of training where they will be able to function as a useful member of the industrial fire brigade. Upon successful completion of this course the participant will be well positioned to pursue additional training including Advanced Exterior, Interior Structural, or certification of the Industrial Fire Brigade Member.
